The Twelfth EUROCVD meeting will continue the tradition, started in Paris (1977) and most recently continued at the same city (1997), of offering every two years a series of conferences on CVD and related topics. The conference will be organised by the Institut de Ciència de Materials de Barcelona ICMAB-C.S.I.C. and will be held at the coastal village of Sitges (Melià Gran Sitges Hotel) near Barcelona on September 5-10, 1999.

The conference is intended to focus on the following topics: fundamentals, modelling, material types, nanoparticles, MOCVD, assisted methods, CVD technology, industrial applications, film characterization, diagnostic tools, and process control.
